- Career and Employment
- Life Post-Studies

Sessions will be delivered by a multitude of presenters and guests including family members, inclusive post-secondary education team members (Inclusion Alberta), faculty, employers, and a student who has been included at a post-secondary institution in Alberta. Each session will have carved out Q&A or participant panel time.
